BINGO \$10,000

Once a week, kids are invited to play bilingual BINGO from the privacy of their own rooms via the in-house TV station. Volunteers are needed every Thursday from 2-4pm to help distribute prizes to patients and siblings.



MOTHER'S DAY \$10,000

In May we hold an annual celebration for patient mothers that includes a buffet brunch, arts and crafts, makeovers, a raffle, and goody bags. Volunteers are needed to help with decorations, assembling goody bags, serving food, and overseeing arts and crafts.



PROM \$10,000

Our annual patient prom provides our teen patients with a chance to experience this milestone event, regardless of their illness. All participants receive donated fashions and enjoy an evening filled with music, food, photography, and fun. Volunteers are needed to help with set-up and assembling gift bags.



TEDDY BEAR CLINIC \$10,000

This special event provides patients and local kids with a chance to explore different hospital departments from the perspective of a teddy bear. Stations include medical play, medical art, casting, dental, nutrition, and many more! Volunteers are needed to help patients pick out their teddy bear and escort them to the stations.



BEACH BOARDWALK \$10,000

This popular summer event includes face painting, carnival games, a magician, art activities, fun prizes and more. Volunteers are needed to help with decorations, prize giveaways and assisting with carnival games.



FATHER'S DAY BBQ \$10,000

In June, we hold an annual barbecue to celebrate Father's Day. Volunteers are needed to assist with serving food, taking photos, running games, and creating a celebratory atmosphere.



HALLOWEEN \$10,000

Halloween is a big celebration at our hospitals! Volunteers are needed to help decorate, distribute costumes to patients at our costume giveaway, participate in reverse trick or treating, and escort patients on the route.



PROJECT CHEER \$10,000

Each winter, our hospitals host Project Cheer, a holiday toy drive where community members are invited to drop off new toys and then stay for hot chocolate, festive music, face painting, and more. Volunteers are needed to help with receiving and sorting toy donations.





PHOTOS WITH SANTA \$10,000

In December, patients have the chance to take a photo with Santa and receive a special gift. Volunteers are needed to assist with setting up Santa's workshop, taking and printing photographs, decorations, distributing gifts, and escorting patients.

HOLIDAY STORE \$10,000

Our Holiday Store is an opportunity for care givers whose children will be hospitalized on Christmas Day to pick out gifts provided by the hospital for their child and all siblings. Volunteers are needed to sort and wrap gifts that will then be delivered to patient rooms between Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.
